Course Description:	<p>The Pre-Kindergarten Reading Program is designed to prepare children to begin reading consonant-vowel-consonant words, phrases, and sentences.</p> <p>The Pre-Kindergarten Accelerated Reading Program is provided for students who have a strong phonics foundation and are able to fluently read consonant-vowel-consonant words and simple, short sentences. Students will be challenged by having to alternate reading both consonant-vowel-consonant words and simple long vowel words along with identifying and reading beginning sight words individually and within sentences.</p>
Methods of Evaluation:	Students will be evaluated through oral reading, teacher observation, and/or scores on Reading Counts quizzes.
Pace of Instruction:	The pace of the instruction is determined by the ability and success of each individual student. As the student's advanced reading progresses, focus will shift to comprehension and critical thinking skills.
Course Objectives:	The objective of the Pre-Kindergarten Reading/Accelerated Reading Curriculum is to meet the student's needs at his or her level and provide them with the instruction that is needed in order to read more difficult material.
