Course Description:	<p>To help students understand God’s world and His creations through exploration and use of their five senses by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Naming three things plants need to grow</li> <li>• Naming parts of a plant</li> <li>• Listing ways that seeds travel</li> <li>• Identifying animals in our environment and tells what they eat and where they live</li> <li>• Identifying products that can come from a farm</li> <li>• Identifying animals that live on the farm</li> <li>• Identifying zoo animals</li> <li>• Knows the characteristics of insects</li> <li>• Names the four seasons and lists the characteristics of each</li> <li>• Uses magnets and explores how they work</li> <li>• Names the five senses and uses them daily to explore and investigate their environment</li> <li>• Explores the characteristics of night and day</li> <li>• Learns about the life cycle of a caterpillar</li> <li>• Learns about the life cycle of a frog</li> </ul>
Methods of Evaluation:	Students can be evaluated through one-on-one assessments, observations, and daily class participation.
Pace of Instruction:	New concepts are introduced weekly/monthly, with continued integration throughout the school year. Concepts are constantly being reviewed and reinforced.
