| Course Description: | To increase knowledge of the art elements and begin to introduce the elements of design through discussion of art reproductions and through production of their own artwork. To introduce more advanced mediums in art and master fine motor skills by using various art tools. To begin making art from close observation and personal experiences as well as to enhance imagination. |

| Pace of Instruction: | 6-9 Lessons / 36 Week Grading Period |
| Course Objectives: | At the end of this course students should be able to: 1. Mix white with colors to create tints and black with colors to create shades (values) 2. Create artworks – drawings, painting, pottery, and mixed media – emphasizing one or more art elements (color, line, shape etc.,) and the principle of design (pattern, rhythm etc.,) 3. Use a variety of art materials and techniques to model, construct, and compose original artwork 4. Demonstrate proper care and safe use of art materials and tools 5. Discuss how culture and environment provide inspiration for creating artwork 6. Apply concepts and ideas from another discipline and its topics as sources of ideas for own artwork 7. Describe red, yellow, and orange as warm colors and green, blue, and violet as cool colors 8. Recognize tints and shades in artwork 9. Differentiate among horizontal, vertical, and diagonal lines 10. Explain how space surrounds two-dimensional shapes and three-dimensional forms 11. Demonstrate how artists use spatial techniques such as overlapping, size, and placement of shapes 12. Identify symmetrical (formal) and radial balance in artwork and in nature 13. Discuss how artists create movement and rhythm in selected artwork 14. Examine two pieces of art of the same subject identifying similarities and differences 15. Discuss expressive qualities of artwork and give personal interpretation of each 16. Demonstrate individual work as well as teamwork 17. Create artwork with the understanding that it will be used to help charity organizations in the community 18. Discuss the role of art and art making in their own lives, in the present and future (career, hobby, expression, etc.) |
