<b>Text:</b>	<i>Positive Action Bible Curriculum: Grade 2 by Cherie Noel,</i> NIV Bible
<b>Supplemental Materials:</b>	Various reproducible Bible story coloring books, various Bible story books Student workbooks
<b>Course Description:</b>	The primary goal throughout the Positive Action Bible Curriculum is to make the Word of God more meaningful to the lives of the students. The class is to introduce children to God's Word and how it applies to their lives. It is to give students a love for God's Word and knowledge of Bible stories to help them know the love of God and the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. Second graders will study the life of Moses through the Book of Exodus. The promises of God will be evident as the Israelites and their leader see both victory and tribulation as they learn to trust God.
<b>Methods of Evaluation:</b>	Students are expected to learn a Bible Verse each week. Each student is expected to participate in classroom activities and complete all assignments.
<b>Pace of Instruction:</b>	Thirty-five weeks of lessons and memory verses.

Value the Bible.</li><li>3. Recall Bible stories.</li><li>4. Comprehend basic Christian doctrine.</li><li>5. Worship God through music.</li><li>6. Understand that we communicate with God through prayer.</li><li>7. Develop an understanding of Biblical vocabulary.</li><li>8. Understand why sin is in the world and why we need a Savior.</li><li>9. Know that Jesus died for our sins and is our only way to heaven.</li><li>10. Respect authority.</li><li>11. Understand the expectancy to listen and to worship God reverently.</li><li>12. Know that the Bible is all TRUE.</li><li>13. Understand that they can find answers in the Word of God for themselves.</li></ol>
