Course Description:	. Fourth grade focuses on the life of Christ from His prophesy to His resurrection. Students learn about the Holy Spirit in the life of the believer and gain an understanding of how Christian character develops using Paul's epistles and the life of Paul from the Book of Acts. By studying the Word of God students acquire knowledge, wisdom, and understanding that teach them how to live from their earliest childhood experiences.
Methods of Evaluation:	Workbook pages, quizzes, Bible memory verse tests
Pace of Instruction:	One lesson per week
Course Objectives:	Analyze the life of Christ from the prophesy of His birth to His resurrection Learn about the land where Christ lived and identify them on a map Describe the miracles that Christ performed while He lived on earth Familiarize students with the books of the Bible Know that studying the word of God can help students have victory over temptation and gain salvation Understand what our response should be to Christ's power Study and analyze the parables of Christ Analyze the lives of the disciples and their importance in spreading the gospel Learn about the Holy Spirit and how it can allow us to develop our inner character Identify the fruits of the Spirit Recognize that when we trust in God, we receive answers to our prayers Develop godly pride for the external qualities God has given us Study the life of King David and compare his life with that of King Saul Learn how to serve God Know how to make wise choices Study the life of Paul Memorize scripture passages that are applicable to students' lives Encourage an active prayer life Understand biblical vocabulary
