

**Text: Harcourt’s “Trophies” Reading Series**

The second grade reading program teaches students to identify the main idea in a given paragraph, comprehend informational text, and identify the setting of a story and understand its importance. After reading, students will identify story characters, comparing and contrasting characters and settings by different authors. Students will recognize main ideas, details, sequence of events, and cause and effect relationships. Novels used during the year may include Days with Frog and Toad, the Cam Jansen series, the Boxcar Children series, and Horrible Harry Cracks the Code.

**Text: Novels and Literature Units**

Second Grade Accelerated Reading is designed for students who are reading at least one grade level above the average beginning second grade reader, scored in the top percentiles on the previous year’s standardized test in reading, and have a SAT Lexile of 700. The Accelerated Reading curriculum includes Stone Fox, Charlotte’s Web, Little House in the Big Woods, and Chocolate Fever.
