	(preliminary, settled, specialized, and concluding ministries)
	and the closing events.
Methods of Evaluation:	Tests are the primary means of evaluation. Notebook checks
	are also evaluated.
Pace of Instruction:	1 st Quarter: Introduction, pre-existence, preparation for
	ministry
	2 nd Quarter: The ministry (preliminary, settled, specialized,
	and concluding ministries) and the closing events.
Course Objectives:	The goal of this course is to study the Life of Jesus
	chronologically using all four gospels. Students should know
	the major events in Jesus' life and understand the significance
	of these events. Jesus' teaching should be applied to each
	student's own life.
