## Failure of a Required Course

In the case of failure of a required course, the course must be retaken. Students can make up a failed course through an SCPS approved summer or online programs. All students must receive approval from the academic advisor before enrolling in credit recovery. If a student repeats a course due to failure, both grades will be reflected on the transcript and calculated into the GPA. The student will receive credit for the credit recovery class when completed with a passing grade. A student may opt to not enroll in summer school and retake any failed class as part of their regular course load the next year if on track to graduate.

However, if a student opts not to participate in summer school to make up for failed course work, they may need to "double up" in that subject area at a later time. If a student does not complete the prerequisites and/or it is deemed that the student cannot complete required course work before the end of the summer of their senior year, they will be asked to withdraw from school. If a student opts to attempt to recovery credit via this path, the student will be placed on Academic Probation until the courses are completed. Failure of the same required class for a second consecutive attempt will result in the student being withdrawn from school. A student must complete all requirements for graduation prior to graduation to be allowed to participate in the ceremony.\*

## \*Any senior who fails a required course may not be permitted to participate in graduation ceremonies.

If the student chooses to take a recovery class, it must be completed by August 1. If not, the student will not be permitted to return for the next school year.

## **Academic Probation**

Academic Probation is invoked when a student has a serious academic problem that may result in the failure of one or more classes. It is intended to give notice to the parent and the student so that mutual effort on the part of both the school and the home may be made to correct the academic deficiency.

## Summer School

SCPS offers an accredited, on-line credit recovery program for students who fail a required course during the academic school year. The program is a self-paced, skills-based program that students complete via their personal technology. A student who fails a course for the year must remediate each semester failed at a cost of \$300 per semester. A student may enroll through SCPS Upper School beginning the first Monday of June. A student can enroll at any time but all work must be completed by the first Friday in August.
