# Welcome to Camp RED!

Savannah Christian presents Camp RED day camp 2024: Into the Wild! Campers can expect space-themed activities, fun in the sun, lots of laughs, and an all-around good time.

In addition to day camp, specialty camps are also available. We offer athletic, academic, and artistic specialty day camps every week! There is something for everyone! (For information on specialty camps, please turn to pages 5-13!)

Camp Red's simple purpose is to provide **R**adically **E**xciting **D**ays for our campers! This is done in an encouraging environment with counselors who care about children and want to see our campers have a wonderful summer experience.

Camp RED is a summer day camp for rising kindergarteners through rising 6th graders in Savannah, GA, and the surrounding areas. The camp is hosted on the 200-acre property of Savannah Christian Preparatory School, which began as a summer camp in 1951. The environment we create at Camp RED is filled with fun activities and at the same time, challenges children to grow in faith and character.



**There is a one-time registration fee of \$40 per child.** This covers all of the camps they register to attend. Camp tuition can be paid in full at the time of registration or you may select a payment plan option.

Camp RED fees include hot/cold lunches prepared by a certified chef, two snacks daily, field trips, a camp t-shirt, and daily camp activities--- including swimming in our swimming pool!

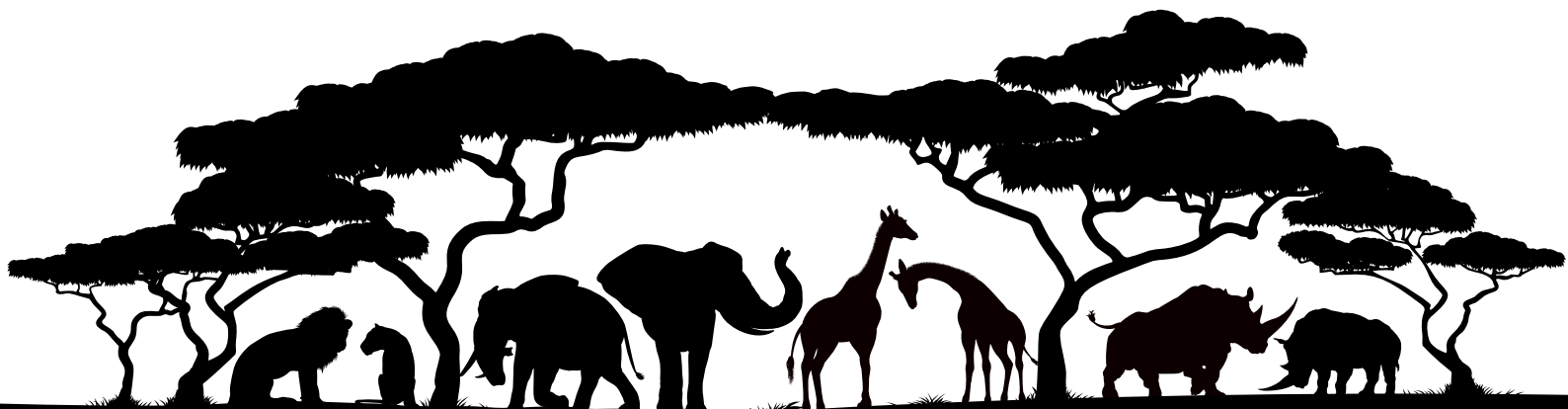

Camp RED is available for rising kindergarteners through rising 6th graders.

Campers are grouped according to age, with 4 age groups in total. Camp RED Staff are CPR/First Aid trained, attending a total of 15 hours of pre-camp training.

Waitlists are used to fill spots as they become available.

Your child DOES NOT need to be a student at SCPS to attend any of our summer programs.



# Payment Options and Cancellations

## Payment Options

**NEW THIS YEAR!** SC Summer Camp provides three payment options for families who are enrolled in camp sessions. All session fees must be paid in full prior to the start of summer camp in order to secure your child's spot for the summer. Families who do not select the pay in full option must enroll in auto-pay.

**Option 1:** All fees are **paid in full** at the time of registration.

**Option 2 (auto pay required):** Fees are divided into **monthly** payments on the following dates-- February 10th, March 10th, April 10th, and May 10th. Payments will begin on the next date after enrollment is approved.

**Option 3 (auto pay required):** Fees are divided into **weekly** payments each Friday, commencing on February 16, 2024 (or the first Friday after enrollment is approved) and ending on May 10, 2024.

## Cancellation Policy

All camp registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

**Cancellations prior to May 10, 2024** are eligible for a full refund, less any registration fees.

**Cancellations after May 10, 2024 and up to 8 days before** the registered week of camp begins are eligible for a 50% refund of camp fees, less any registration fees paid.

**Cancellations 7 days or less** prior to the start of the camp week are not eligible for a refund. All fees will be forfeited.

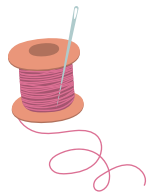

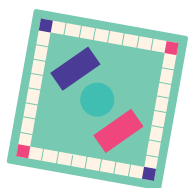
