

Pre-Kindergarten Supply List

- (2) 16 pack of Crayola crayons (regular size)
- (2) 10 pack box of Crayola markers (classic colors – packs include pink and gray)
- (4) jumbo glue sticks ****Elmer's "Disappearing Purple" works BEST****
- (2) 4 oz. bottles of white Elmer's glue (no gel or color glue) NOT Elmer's washable/no run glue
- (1) pack of rectangular Pink Pearl Erasers
- (2) rectangular (not cylinder) plastic boxes of baby wipes
- (1) pair of Fiskars for Kids scissors with *round* tips
- (1) box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- (1) box of sandwich size Ziploc bags
- (4) boxes of **5 oz. CLEAR** bathroom cups
- (4) rolls of Bounty paper towels
- (1) box of Mr. Clean Magic Erasers
- (2) cylinders of disinfectant wipes (ex. Clorox wipes)
- (1) large rectangular box of Kleenex Tissues

Please only label (first and last name) the items below:

- (1) Plastic pencil box (no larger than 6" x 9" – easy for your child to open and close).
- (1) book bag **(standard size – 16" x 12" **SIZE IS VITAL**!!!**– NO character book bags or rolling book bags of any kind.) The book bag needs to be able to hold a folder, jacket, lunchbox, beach towel, special projects, etc. **ALL AT ONE TIME.**
- (1) set of extra labeled uniform clothes , including socks & undergarments in large Ziploc bag ***(necessary and required)***
- (1) Lunchbox will be needed if your child will be bringing lunch from home.
- (1) beach towel for rest time

Important Notes

Your child's book bag should not display any character pictures. Canvas is usually the best type because it will last throughout the school year. The size is also very important (***Multiple items such as lunch boxes, mat sheets, beach towels, jackets, large envelopes, crafts, etc. should fit easily in the book bag.***)

Lunch boxes are only used if your child is bringing lunch from home. Please send a juice box or something similar for your child's drink. Thermoses are cumbersome and can spill easily. If your child brings lunch from home, they may purchase milk from the lunchroom.

Snack should be placed in a **disposable bag and placed in the front pocket of the child's book bag.** Your child will only need one or two small snacks. **NO drinks need to be sent with snacks.** Students will drink water for snack. Snacks should be healthy. **Fresh fruit that is ready to eat (ex.: peeled oranges, sliced apples),** applesauce, crackers, carrots, celery, yogurt, cheese snacks, dry cereal or cereal bars are great choices. **PLEASE send utensils with snack items.** We discourage cookies, donuts, pudding, etc.

Please only purchase the specific items described in the supply list. If you are unable to locate a specific item, do not purchase an item that is similar. Instead, speak with your child's teacher at the orientation. Shopping early will help you find all the specific items your child will need.

You should bring your child's supplies to the Parent/Student Visitation Day (NOT TO THE PARENT ORIENTATION, WHICH IS HELD AT NIGHT).

Student Fee

The student fee is due on the first day of school. The student fee covers the cost of mat sheets, Georgia Day activities, field trips, specific projects and a Lower School Field Trip T-shirt.
