

Bible - Kindergarten

Supplemental Materials:	Abeka ABC Bible memory cards, Bible drills, Abeka pictures of all Bible stories, and “Sing Unto the Lord” CD of hymns and choruses.
Course Description:	The primary goal of the Abeka curriculum is to make the Word of God meaningful to the lives of the students. The curriculum provides a foundation of the Old and New Testaments through various Bible stories. As the children learn God’s Word through these Bible stories the hope is that they will learn to love Jesus Christ as their Savior. In addition, our hope is that they apply their knowledge of God’s Word to their lives. Bible topics covered during Kindergarten are: Salvation, Creation, Old Testament characters, Thanksgiving, Christmas, the Ministry of Jesus and the Crucifixion and Resurrection of Jesus.
Methods of Evaluation:	Students are expected to learn a Bible verse each week and will be evaluated one-on-one. Each student is expected to participate in classroom activities such as singing, answering doctrinal questions, and answering questions about Bible stories previously taught. Teacher observation (i.e., visually and audibly) of student performance will be noted weekly.
Pace of Instruction:	Two to three new lessons a week, with one or two days devoted to reviewing previously taught lessons.
Course Objectives:	At the end of this course students should be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recall some Bible verses previously memorized. 2. Value the Bible as God’s Holy Word. 3. Recall Bible stories. 4. Know that all of the Old Testament leads up to the New Testament where God fulfills all His promises that He made in the Old Testament. 5. Comprehend basic Christian doctrine. 6. Worship God through music. 7. Understand we communicate with God through prayer. 8. Know that God created the world and all that is in it. 9. Understand why sin is in the world and why we need a Savior. 10. Know that Jesus died for our sins and is our only way to heaven. 11. Respect authority. 12. Understand the expectancy to listen and to worship God reverently. 13. Know that the Bible is all TRUE.
