(Example: John Doe- Science 89)

Go to grades.savcps.com, log on with your user name and password, go to Student’s Grades, scroll down to Report Card and click. You should be able to view a digital copy of your child’s midterm report. (You may be asked to click again if your browser offers you that option.)
