

SAVANNAH CHRISTIAN WASHINGTON DC TRIP FACT SHEET

REGISTRATION: Please cut off and return the deposit portion of the registration form to your homeroom teacher by November 4. Make all checks payable to Savannah Christian. Please indicate any special needs or dietary restrictions on your form.

CHAPERONES: Each school-assigned chaperone will be responsible for approximately 10 students throughout the trip.

MEDICATION: All medication should be clearly marked and given to your chaperone at the beginning of the trip.

TRANSPORTATION: Travel will be on deluxe, late-model Excursions Unlimited motorcoaches. There are charging stations at each seat, as well as WIFI on the bus. There will be no food, beverages, or gum permitted on the bus. We will take rest breaks, at which time snacks and drinks will be distributed outside the bus.

LUGGAGE: Each student will be allowed one suitcase to be placed under the motorcoach, and one carry on bag for inside the bus. Please do not put anything in your overnight bag that you may need while traveling, as you will not have access to it until we reach our destination.

DRESS CODE: Students will be given 4 t-shirts to be worn each day of the trip. Wear comfortable shoes, as we will be doing quite a bit of walking. The weather should still be cool at that time of year, so bring appropriate outerwear.

SPENDING MONEY: Students may wish to purchase souvenirs while on the trip. While there is no set amount, we recommend bringing \$10-20 per day. Also, two meals are not included in the trip cost, so please plan accordingly.

CELL PHONES/ELECTRONICS: Cell phones will be allowed on the trip, but use will be closely monitored by chaperones during touring. We recommend they be used only for taking pictures while sightseeing. All other electronic devices should be left on the bus or in the hotel room.

CANCELLATION: The \$100 deposit is refundable up until the final payment due date. Cancellation from February 17-March 1 will result in \$100 penalty. If a trip is cancelled from March 1 until date of departure there will be a loss of \$299.
