Students should feel comfortable enough with their two books to summarize the book and to give an opinion on the book to other readers. For the fiction book, have students look for main characters, setting, the problem, the solution, and the plot (beginning, middle, and end). Students should be able to give three ideas or interesting facts about their nonfiction book.
