## Outerwear

Grades 6-12 may only wear SCPS uniform outerwear on campus, unless otherwise noted by administration. Grades PK-5 may wear non-uniform coats and jackets outside and when coming to and from school. Any SCPS uniform outerwear must have "SCPS", "Raiders", the mascot, or "Savannah Christian Preparatory School" embroidered or printed on the outerwear.

All SCPS uniform outerwear must be purchased from an approved uniform supplier, PTF, or Raider Athletics. Uniform outerwear from unauthorized suppliers is not permitted.

Hooded sweatshirts may only be worn by Upper School (grades 9-12) students on Spirit Days or during the winter months (beginning of November until the end of February).

All non-uniform outerwear is permitted when the temperature is expected to be 32 degrees or below at any point during the school day.

Rainwear: during inclement weather, students may wear a raincoat while commuting between buildings. Upon entrance into the building the jacket should be removed.

## Daily Uniform Reminders

1. Boys must be clean-shaven.
2. Hair should be neatly styled, out of the eyes, and not a distraction to the learning environment.
3. Extreme or fad hair styles are not permitted. Hair must be a natural color. "Unusual" hair coloring is not permitted.
4. Hats may be worn during the school day only if part of a team or class that requires the hat for an activity.
5. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings. Visible tattoos or body piercing(s) (including temporary ones) are not allowed.
6. Students must wear proper uniforms on field trips unless the principal grants special permission.

## Formal Dress Days (Grades 6-12)

Middle and upper school students will be required to dress in "formal dress day" wear for certain chapel and other special events. Students should wear school uniforms every Wednesday unless otherwise specified. Students and parents will be given ample notice when a formal
dress day is required for a special event. Please refer to the requirements below for a breakdown of our formal dress day guidelines.

Girls

- Official uniform plaid skirt
- White long-sleeved or short-sleeved, button down oxford cloth or broadcloth
- Brown or black closed-toe shoes - no tennis shoes

Boys

- Khaki trousers
- White long-sleeved or short-sleeved, button down oxford cloth
- Uniform tie - Navy/red stripe or Raider tie, or bow tie
- Brown or black closed-toe shoes - no tennis shoes

The tables below provide a breakdown of our uniform regulations. Uniform regulations apply for grades PK-12, unless otherwise noted.

## Girls

| Skirt <br> Official uniform plaid | Girls may wear a skirt that when standing straight with relaxed shoulders must be no more than five (5) inches from the front of the knee. <br> For grades PK-5, red uniform shorts must be worn under skirts and jumpers. |

| Skorts and Jumpers Official uniform plaid | Girls may wear a skort or jumper that when standing straight with relaxed shoulders must be no more than five (5) inches from the front of the knee. <br> For grades PK-5, red uniform shorts must be worn under jumpers. |
| Pants | Black or khaki trousers |
| Shorts | Girls may wear khaki shorts that when standing straight with relaxed shoulders must be no more than five (5) inches from the front of the knee. *Boat/swim shorts are not allowed. PK-5: Khaki or black shorts |
| Shirts | White short or long-sleeved, button-down oxford cloth or broadcloth. Red or white knit shirt with SCPS monogram. No oversized shirts. Solid white turtlenecks may be worn under longsleeved uniform shirt. *Shirts must fit properly and be tucked in neatly at all times. |
| Vest | OPTIONAL: Red V-Neck, sleeveless pullover with SCPS embroidered |
| Belt | Belts must be worn with pants |
| Shoes | Closed-toe and closed-heel tennis or dress shoes |
| Leggings | Black or navy blue leggings may be worn under uniform skirts. Leggings must be fitted and not loose, such as tights. *Sweatpants, flared leggings, and yoga pants are not allowed |
| Socks | Socks should be predominately white, black, or gray. Extreme or fad socks are not permitted. |

## Boys

| Pants | Khaki trousers |

| Shorts | Boys may wear khaki shorts that when standing straight with relaxed shoulders must be no <br> more than five (5) inches from the front of the knee. *Boat/swim shorts are not allowed. |
| Shirts | White, short or long-sleeved button-down oxford cloth. Red or white short or long-sleeved <br> knit shirt with SCPS monogram. *Shirts must fit properly and be tucked in neatly at all <br> times. |
| Vest | Red V-Neck, sleeveless pullover with SCPS embroidered |
| Belt | Grades 1-12: a belt must be worn with pants or shorts |
